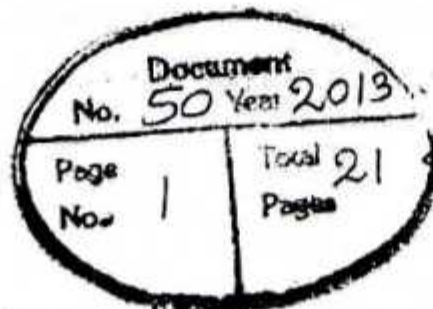

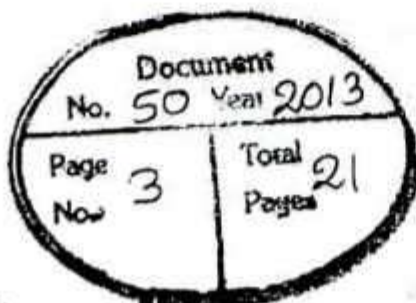

WHEREAS the AUTHOR of the Trust is desirous of establishment of a Trust for public educational purposes, has contributed an initial sum of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand Only) as nucleus of the said Trust and has handed over the said sum to the trustee hereinafter mentioned, to be held by the said trustee upon trust for **AKSHAYAH EDUCATIONAL TRUST**.

WHEREAS the Author hereby declares the objects and purposes of the Trust and other matters connected with the management and conduct of the trust.

NOW THIS DEED OF TRUST WITNESSETH AND DECLARES AS FOLLOWS:

1. **NAME OF THE TRUST :** **AKSHAYAH EDUCATIONAL TRUST**
2. **OFFICE :** The Registered office of the Trust shall function at No.8, 1st Street, LIC Colony, TANSI Nagar, Velachery, Chennai-42. The Registered office may be shifted to any other place as decided by the



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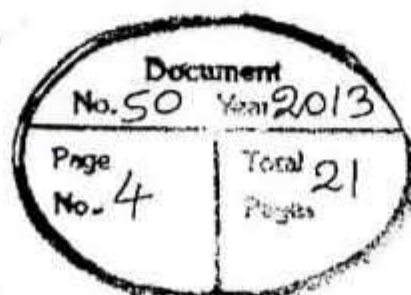


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Founder and Managing Trustee from time to time by means of a resolution.

3. OBJECTS :

a. To establish, maintain, run, develop, improve, extend, grant donations for and to aid assist in the establishment, maintenance, running development, improvement and extension of play School, Crèche, Kinder Garden, Nursery School, Elementary School, Residential School, Higher Secondary, Matriculation School, International School and other Art, Craft and Science School, Colleges whether general, technical, Vocational, Professional or of any other description of such as Arts, Science, Commerce, Computer Courses, Engineering Sciences, Medical and Para Medical Science, Agricultural Science, Computer Sciences and more particularly Engineering College, Law Colleges, Dental College, Medical College, Agricultural College, Polytechnics, Teacher Training College having undergraduate and diploma courses and to institute and award Scholarship for study, research and apprenticeship for all or any of the said purpose, for the purpose of rendering philanthropic and educational services to the public in general and more particularly to all the poor, minority communities, schedule caste, schedule tribes who are living



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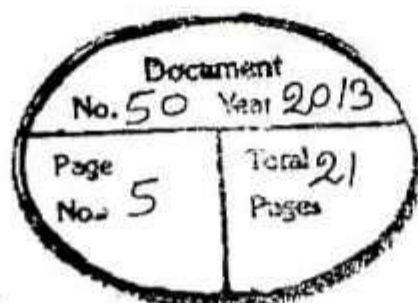


in village, towns, cities who suffer from social and economic backwardness and thereby to pave way for their social and economic development.

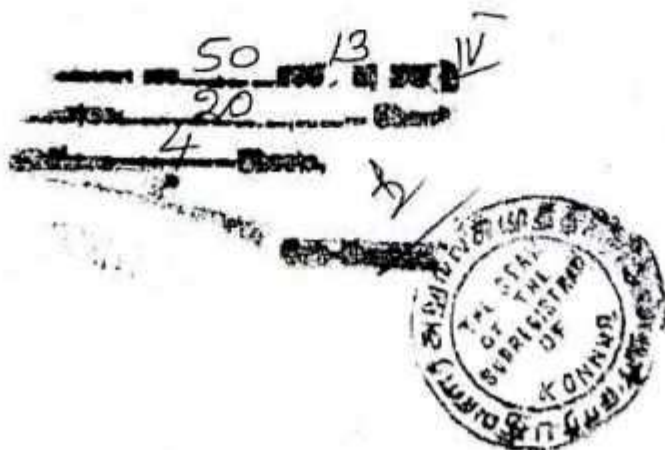
b. To conduct, institute and carry on discourses, lectures and class for the propagation of adult educational in India and to open, run, continue, develop, improve, extend, grant donations and to assist in the establishment, maintenance, running, development, improvement for extension of such institutions for the aforesaid purpose for the uplift of the old and illiterate people in villages, towns and cities both men and women and thereby to pave way for their social and economic development.

c. To bring out, encourage, develop and grant donations for the inventive and research facilities of the pupils and teachers and to afford opportunity for research work in Arts, Science and Industrial undertaking.

d. To establish, maintain, run, develop, improve, extend and grant donations for and to aid assist in the establishment, maintenance, running, development, improvement and extension of hospitals, surgical houses, maternity centre, Natural Health Hospitals and Clinics and such other similar institutions as would give medical and



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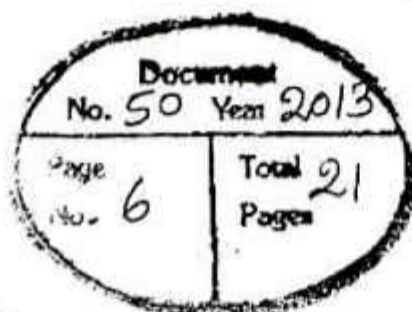


surgical treatment care, cure, recuperation and other advantages by way of alleviating and suffering of mankind in India.

e. To establish, maintain, run, develop, improve, extend and grant donations for and to aid and assist in the establishment, maintenance, running, development, improvement and extensions of institutions of institutions to give medical aid and education to the handicapped and orphans for their rehabilitation and thereby pave way for their social and economic development.

f. To grant donations and subscriptions for and to aid assist persons who are stricken with poverty of sickness, to grant, donations and subscriptions for the relief of the need and handicapped persons.

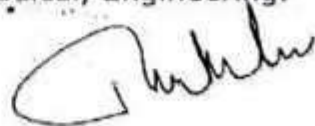
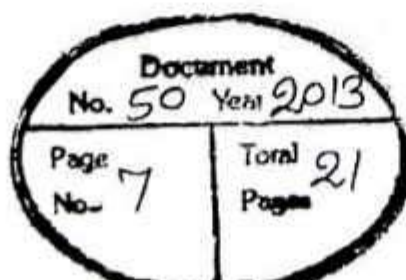
g. To establish, maintain, run, develop, improve, extend, grant donations for and to aid and assist in the establishment maintenance, running, development, improvement and extension of hostels and boarding houses for students, working men and working women in cities, towns and such other places, to provide security and to improve their educational and employment opportunities and to pave way for their social and economic development.



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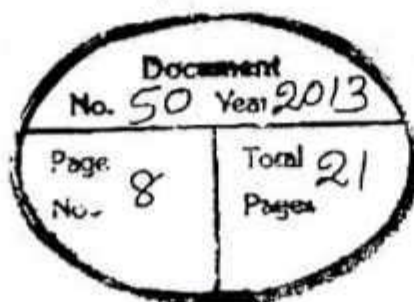


- h. To provide food, residence and clothing, monetary aid to the poor to provide relief for those stricken by natural calamities such as flood, earthquake, cyclone and storm and fire accident in India.
- i. To take over any existing, institutions, hospital of the kind referred to in the above said clauses in India and to conduct, run, maintain, develop, extend and improve the same.
- j. Generally to provide donations and bounties for the fulfillment of the objects mentioned above the people of India, more particularly in Tamil Nadu.
- k. To provide and grant donations to other Charitable and Educational Trust having objects similar to those of this Trust.
- l. To take over any existing trusts having objects similar to this trust, or to take over any institutions run by such trusts and to help such trusts institutions in all the aspects and also give funds to those trusts and institutions by way of loans etc.,
- m. To organize medical centre for children's care and to provide free medical and to the deserving people of the nation.
- n. To establish conduct and maintain a chain of educational institutions and approved national lines in Medical, Engineering.

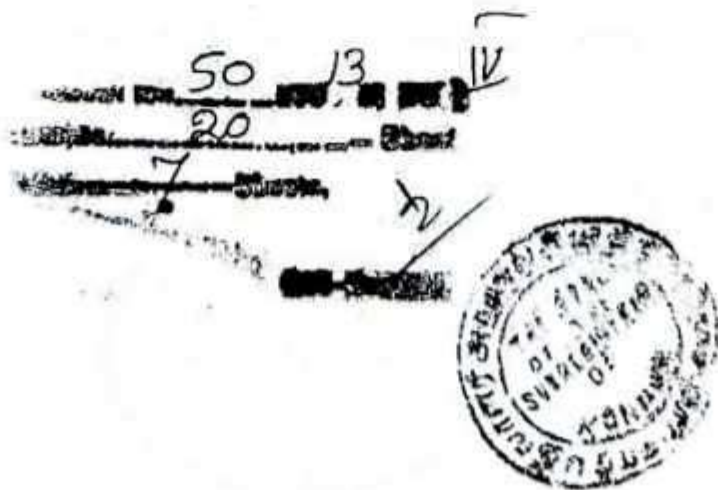

- o. To print magazine and publish to the public such things for bringing the awareness about the Naturopathy treatment among them, through magazine, audio and video visual.
- p. To design need based training programme for women, children and the Handicapped to impart the requisite skill and knowledge to take a career and to provide opportunities for gainful self employment.
- q. To provide National Integration among all.
- r. To encourage the executive Women's National Development Activities.
- s. To do all other things that may be incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objective or any of them.
- t. Arranging for the economic up-liftment of socially handicapped and other deserving needy women like widow, divorced women, and deserving wives/daughter/sons of Jawans.
- u. To establish and develop research centre and academic for the pursuit knowledge to assist deserving and poor students and scholars in pursuit of knowledge of education in Naturopathy.
- v. To provide job oriented courses like Diploma In Naturopathy, Allopathy, Homeopathy, Ayurvedic, Siddha, Unani Medicines,



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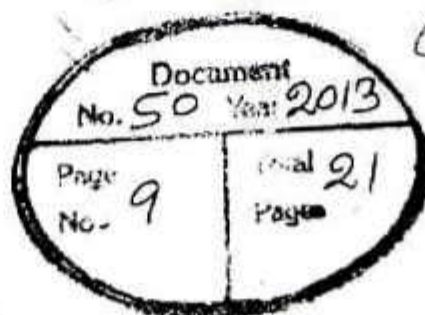
alternative systems and to start M.Pharm, B.Pharm, D.Pharm Courses to provide education in paramedical courses like Nursing, Theater, Assistant Lab Technician.

w. To provide general relief by subscribing to or establish charitable dispensaries, hospitals, clinics, or to provide medical and maternity assistance to the poor people.

x. To start Reserch Centre in large scale by getting monetary assistance from abroad for the benefit of the affected people like AIDS, T.B, Leprosy and any type of Medical and Agricultural Reserches. To arrange and organize Health Clubs with non profit motive basis for weaker section of the nation.

4. TRUST FUND

The Author hereby declares that a sum of Rs.1000/- (One Thousand Only) has been handed over in trust and dedicated for public, educational purposes, shall be held by the trustees upon trust and also any other money or properties which the trust may acquire from time to time for augmenting the trust fund by way of contributions and donations in cash, cheque or any kind of movable and or immovable properties.

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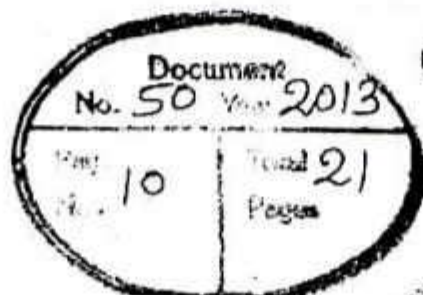
5. FIRST TRUSTEES AND MANAGING TRUSTEE

The Trustees shall be 1. **T.K.VENKATESH** son of Late T.K.Kumaraswamy aged about 38 years residing at No.5, 2nd Floor, Sreenivas Apartments, Door No.147, St.Marys Road, Chennai-18 and 2.Mrs.K.RAJALAKSHMI, wife of Late T.K.Kumaraswamy aged about 72 years residing at No.69A, Chamiers Road, Chennai-18.

T.K.VENKATESH shall be the Managing Trustee and Chairman for his life time. The Managing Trustee has the power to appoint his successors during his life time and in case of his death one of his legal heirs shall be the Managing Trustee, who shall be so, for his/her life time.

6. APPOINTMENT AND REMOVAL OF TRUSTEES OTHER THAN MANAGING TRUSTEE

- a. The number of trustees including the Managing Trustee shall not be less than two and not more than seven.
- b. The Managing Trustee shall have the power to nominate additional Trustees from time to time not exceeding seven on such terms and conditions as he deems fit.
- c. Each of the Trustees nominated by the Managing Trustee shall hold office for a period of three years only from the date of their



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appointment as stated above. However they are eligible for re-appointment at the discretion of the Managing Trustee.

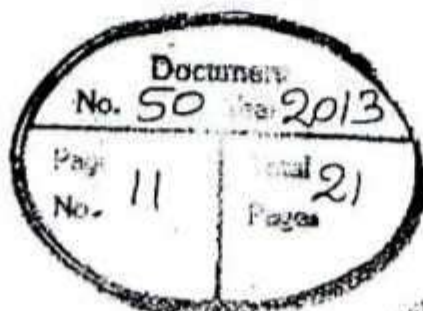
d. The Vacancy among the Trustees may or may not be filled up at the discretion of the Managing Trustee but the minimum number of trustees shall not be less than two.

e. The Managing Trustee shall have the power to remove all or any of the Trustee from office before the expiry of the term for which they are mentioned.

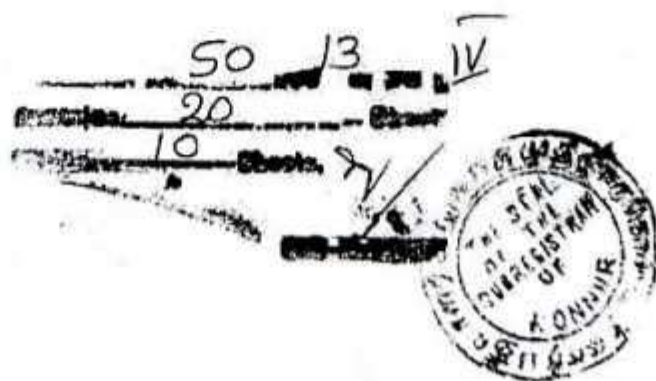
f. The Managing Trustee shall have the power to appoint any one of the Trustees to act as Managing Trustee or Chairman during the absence in the office due to any extraneous circumstances and such Managing Trustee or Chairman shall hold office for the specific period with such specific powers as may be prescribed by the Managing Trustee in writing. The Managing Trustee shall also have the power to remove such person or persons acting as Managing Trustee for which they are thus appointed.

7. BANK ACCOUNTS

One or more bank accounts shall be opened in any scheduled bank and or Nationalized Bank in the name of the Trust and the Managing Trustee shall operate the Bank Account(s) on



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behalf of the Trust and shall receive and pay money on behalf of the trust. However, Managing Trustee is empowered to authorize anyone or more of Trustees to operate the Bank Account(s) on her behalf by means of a resolution.

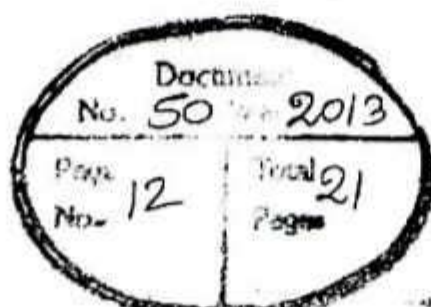
8. BORROWINGS

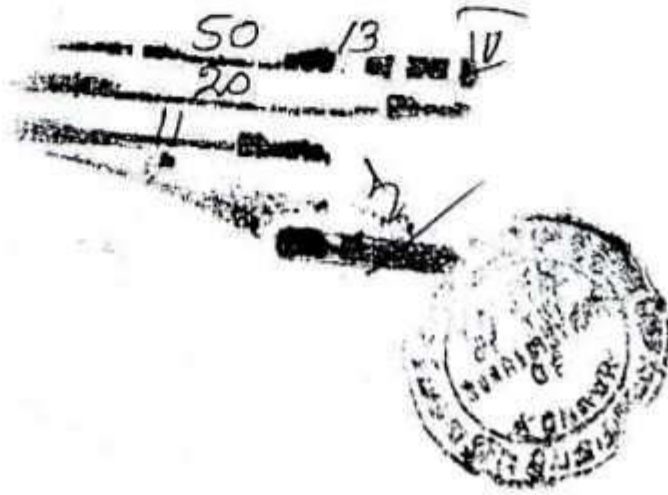
The trust can borrow funds for implementing or carrying out any of the objects and purposes of the Trust from any Scheduled or Nationalized Bank, Financial Institutions or Private parties on security by mortgaging or pledging any of the immovable or movable properties of the Trust or without security on such interest and on such terms and conditions.

9. MANAGEMENT

The General Management of the affairs of the Trust shall vest with the Managing Trustee. The Managing Trustee shall have an advisory Board consisting of not more than five members for consultations.

The advice of the advisory Board is only directory and not mandatory subject to the approval of the Managing Trustee who shall have discretionary power either to accept the advice or to reject the advice of the Board.

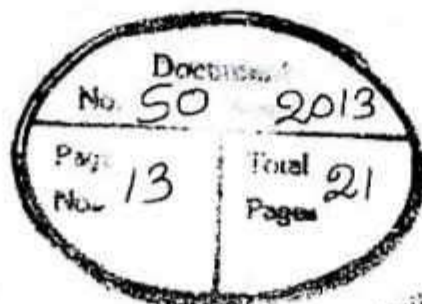




The persons so appointed as members of the Board can be removed at any time by the Managing trustee at his discretion without notice.

THE GENERAL AND SPECIFIC DUTIES AND POWERS OF MANAGING TRUSTEES

- a. The Managing Trustee shall have powers to give directions for all the activities of the Trust.
- b. The Managing Trustee shall be responsible for all the activities of the Trust and institutions run by it and shall be the person to sue and be sued for and on behalf of the Trust.
- c. The Managing Trustee shall have powers to accept any donations, grants, subscriptions and contributions from any government, Local Authorities, Corporation, Firms, Companies, Individuals or other person or from any other Charitable Trust or Institutions whether they be in cash, Cheque, or in other forms including movable or immovable properties for the purposes and for the fulfillment of the objects of this Trust.



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d. The Managing Trustee shall have all powers necessary for, incidental to carrying out the objects of this Trust effectively.

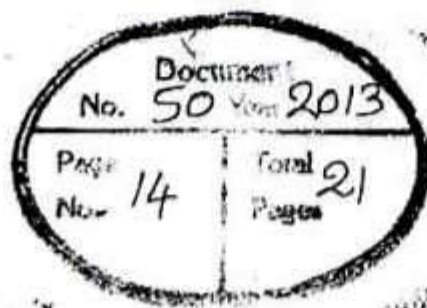
e. Subject to the general provisions of the Trust and without prejudice to the general and specified powers conferred upon the Managing Trustee and Chairman by the provisions contained in these presents, the Managing Trustee and Chairman shall have the following specific powers:

i. To apply the Trust money to effectuate any one or some of the object of the Trust in preference to other object.

ii. To discontinue the application of Trust funds to one object and divert the funds to another object.

iii. To decide the nature, objects and functions of all institutions to be established by the Trust and to decide whether and if so what existing institutions or institutions may be taken over by the Trust or to which financial aid may be given.

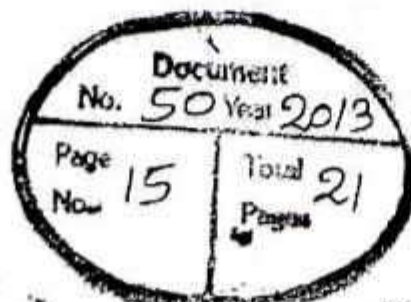
iv. To determine the terms and conditions on which any donations, subscriptions, scholarships or prizes, loans etc., are to be given by the Trust.



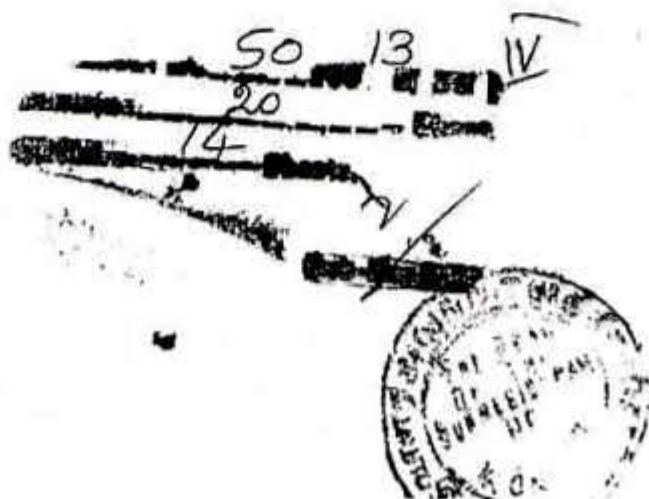
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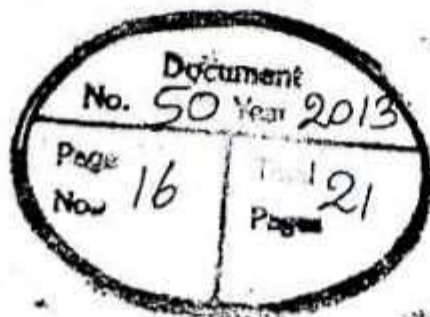
- v. To acquire, build upon, pull down, renovate, rebuild, add to alter repair improve any land, building or premises and other immovable properties and carrying out any of the objects of the Trust.
- vi. To expand the funds of the Trust in such manner as he may consider more beneficial for the purposes of the Trust.
- vii. To sell or dispose of any land, building or premises and such movable property and also any movable properties of the Trust or any of the Institutions run by the Trust at any time when the situation warrants the same for the purpose of carrying out any of the objects of the trust.
- viii. To acquire or to lease any movable and / or immovable property of others and develop, let out any movable and / or immovable property of the trust on lease or hire for the purpose of carrying out any of the objects of the Trust for such period as may be decided by the Managing Trustee.
- ix. To acquire any movable and / or immovable property in exchange of some other property of the Trust or partly in such exchange and partly for other consideration.



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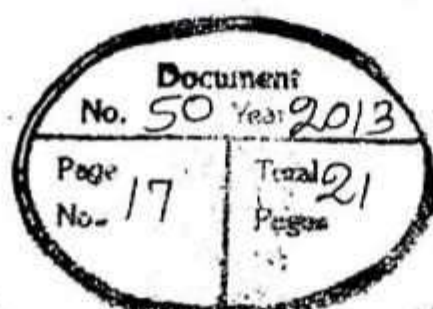
- x. To enter into any contract on behalf of the Trust for the purpose of carrying out any of the objects of the Trust.
- xi. To borrow funds for implementing or carrying out any of the objects and purposes the Trust from any Bank, Financial Institutions or private parties on the security by mortgaging or pledging any of the movable and / or immovable properties of the Trust or without security, on such interest and terms and conditions and to execute necessary documents or mortgage deeds on behalf of the Trust for such borrowings.
- xii. To make donations from the Trust Funds to any person or institutions to carry out any of the objects similar to the objects of the Trust not contravening the clauses herein.
- xiii. To frame, make and enforce and such rules, regulations and byelaws from me to time not inconsistent with the express provisions of the Trust for securing and facilitating the administrations and management of the various activities and affairs of the trust and the institutions run be the Trust and for convening, conducting the meeting in referred the Trust and institutions run by the Trust.

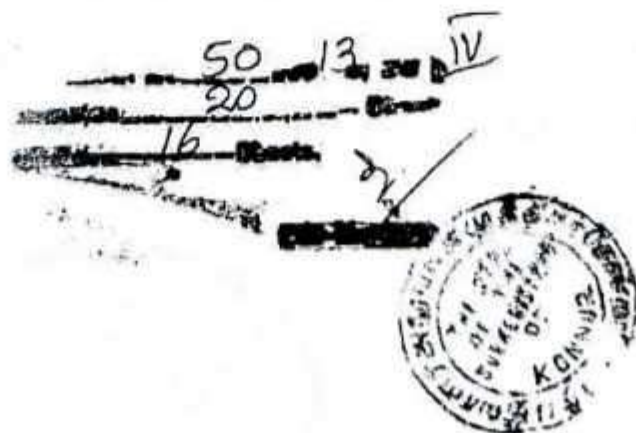

- xiv. To repeal, alter, amend, rescind or add to, all such rules, regulations and byelaws from time to time as he may think necessary for the purpose of carrying out the objects of the Trust.
- xv. To appoint or engage and at his discretion to remove, dismiss or suspend any of the officials or employees or servants in permanent or temporary or special service in connection with the work of the Trust or the Institutions run by the Trust and to determine their powers and duties and fix their salaries and emoluments, bonus and other allowances, if any and to require security in such instance and such amount as he thinks fit. The Managing Trustee shall pay the salary, bonus and other incidental expenses of the staff of Institution or any other person or carry out the objects of the Trust.
- xvi. To declare and constitute a fresh or separate Trust(s) for more efficiently carrying out any of the objects of the objects of this Trust and to transfer such properties or funds or this Trust as may be necessary to the said new Trust(s) so constituted.
- xvii. The Managing Trustee may at any time delegate all or any of their duties and powers to any other person or persons, whether Trustees or not or to any committee or sub committee appointed by him for execution of such specific work as may be assigned by them





for the effective administration of the activities of the Trust and the Institutions run by it.

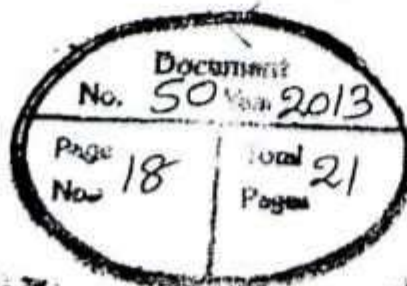
xviii. The Managing Trustee and Chairman shall have or cause to have the custody of all deeds and documents of titles relating to the Trust properties and investments and Books of Accounts relating to the Trust.

xix. Managing Trustee and Chairman shall keep proper Books of Accounts for all income and expenditure of the Trust.

xx. The Accounts of the Trust shall be audited by Chartered Accountant/s who shall be appointed for the above purpose by the Managing Trustee.

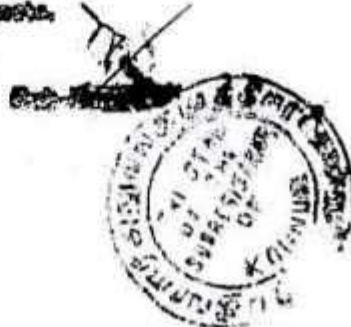
xxi. The Managing Trustee and Chairman shall have powers from time to time to alter this deed of Trust or any of its clauses as he may think fit after getting due approval from the concerned authorities.

10. The income of the Trust accumulated or set apart, either in whole or in part, for application to such purpose in India for the fulfillment of any of the objects of Trusts, shall be invested or deposited in the forms and modes in accordance with the provisions of section 13(1) (d) read with Sec. 11(5) of the Income Tax Act and /



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or as per any statutory modifications made in the Income Tax Act from time to time.

11. The Trust hereby declared, shall be irrevocable.

12. The Income of funds of the Trust shall be solely towards the object of the Trust and no portion of it will be utilized for payment to Trustee by way of Profit, Interest Dividends, etc., None of the Trustee shall hold place of profit in the Trust.

13. The benefits of the Trust are open to all irrespective of caste, Religions, Sex etc.,.

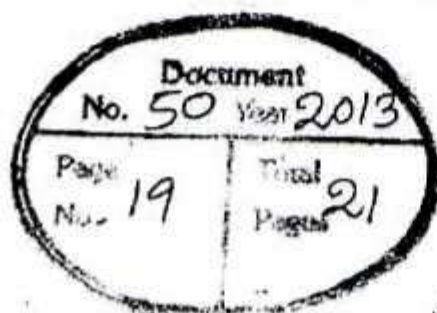
14. After obtaining registration u/s 12A with the Income Tax Department.

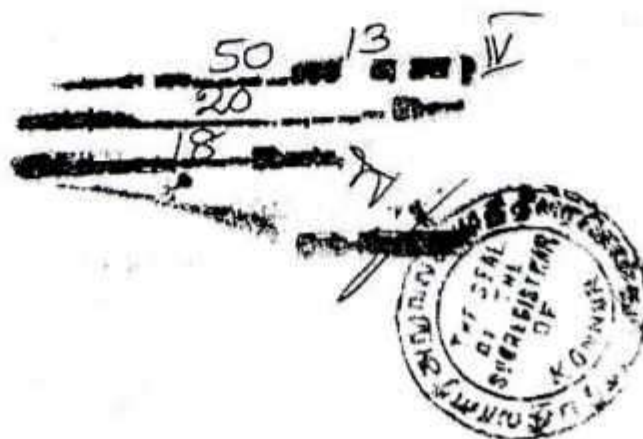
a. Any future amendments in the Trust Deed shall be carried out only with the approval of the Commissioner of Income Tax.

b. Acquisitions / alienation of immovable property shall be done with prior approval of the Director of Income Tax (Exemptions) Chennai.

15. The Trust should not carry on activity with the intention of earning profit.

16. The activities of the Trust would be confined to the territory of India.





17. The funds of the Trust would not be applied for any religious purposes or given to religious institutions.

18. In the event of dissolution of the above said Trust namely **AKSHAYAH EDUCATIONAL TRUST**, the net asset of the Trust as on the date of dissolution will be transferred to another Charitable Educational Trust having objects similar to those of this Trust.

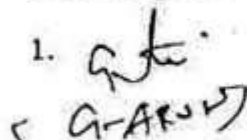
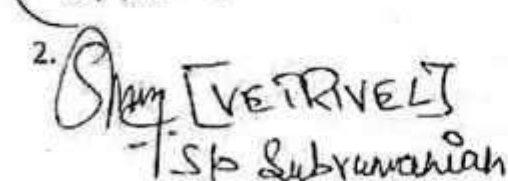
19. No immovable property is involved in this trust other than the corpus fund of Rs.1000/- (one thousand only).

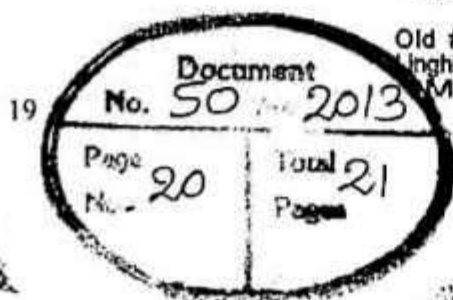

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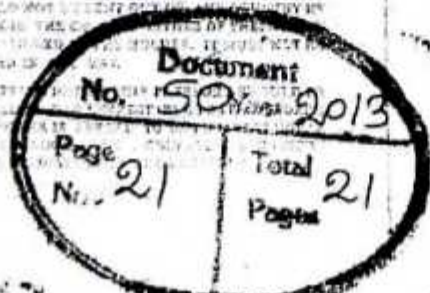
